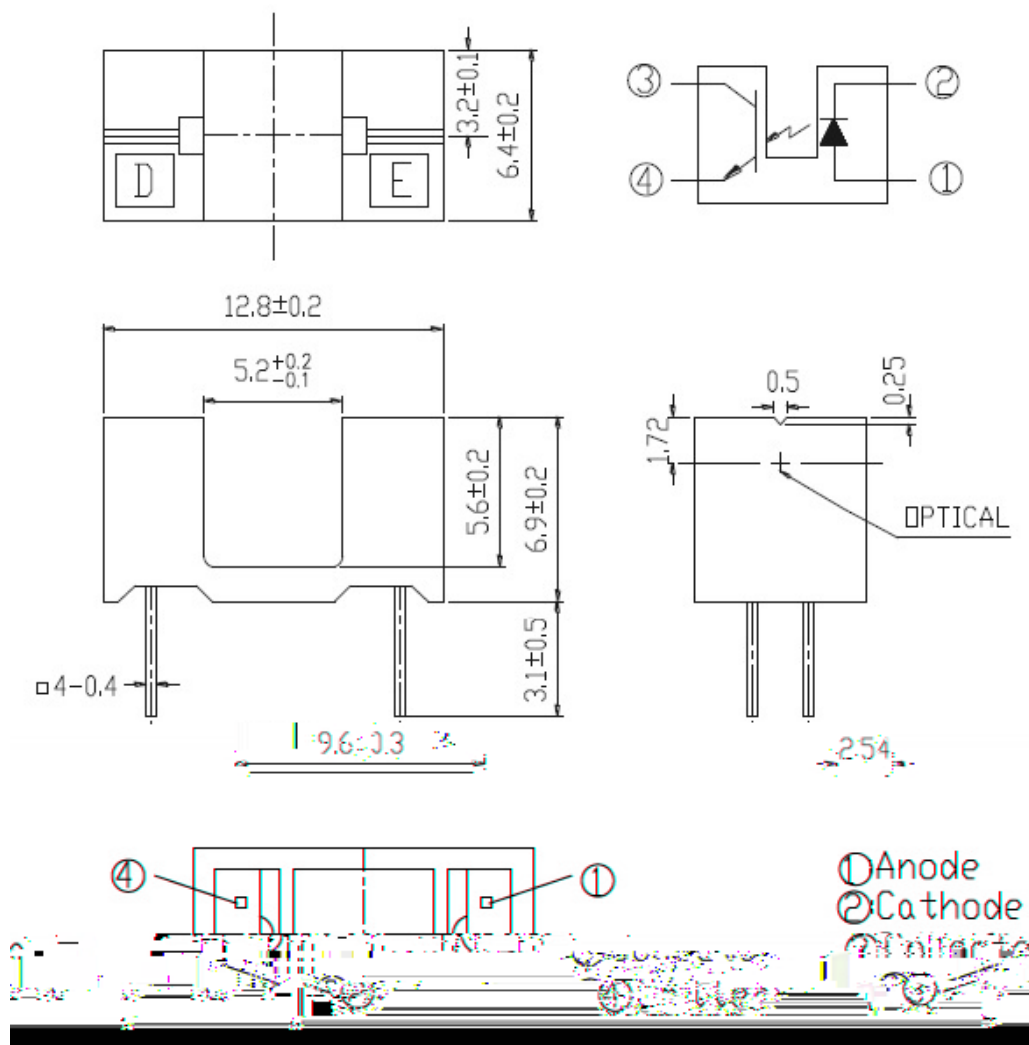

Fig.1 Forward Current vs. Ambient Temperature

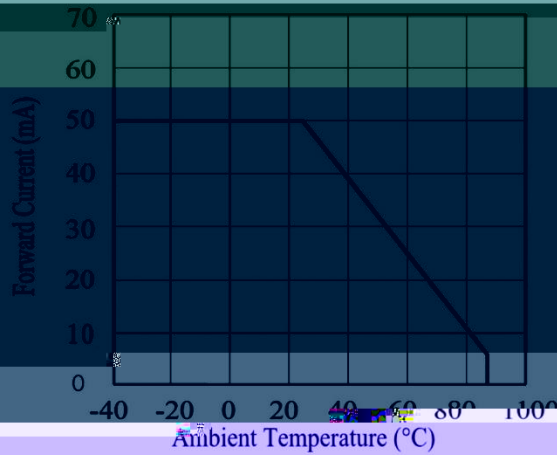


Fig.2 Spectral Distribution

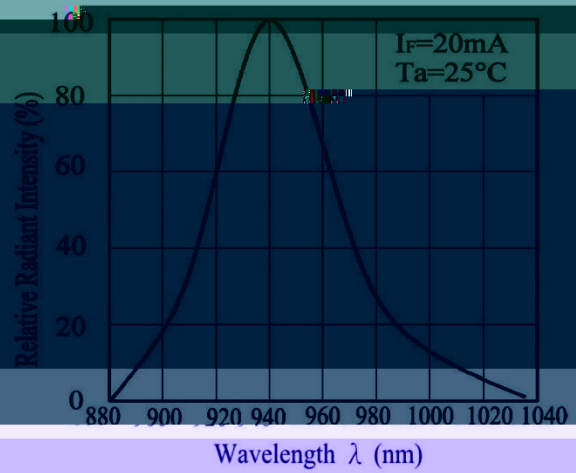


Fig.3 Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage

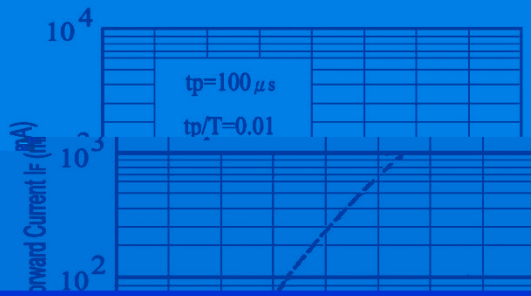
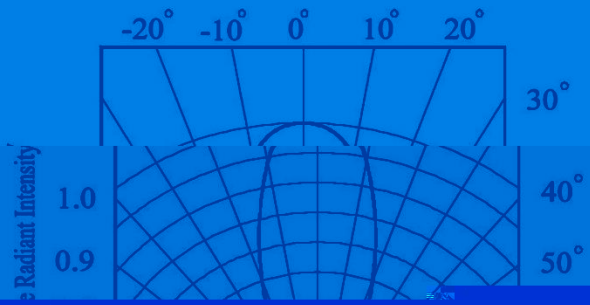


Fig.4 Relative Radiant Intensity vs. Angular Displacement

Fig.2 Collector Current vs. Irradiance

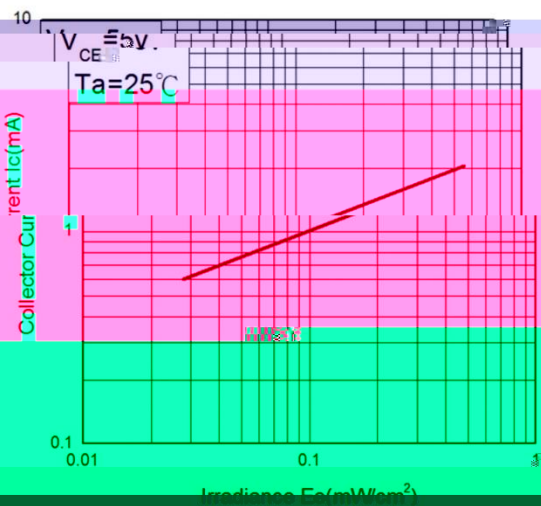
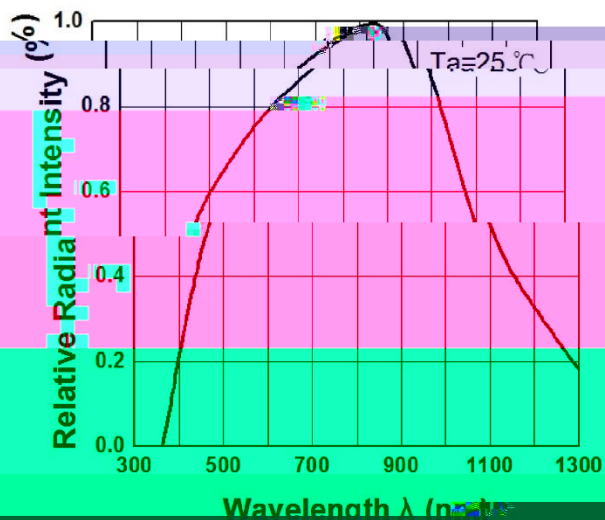


Fig.3 Collector Current vs. Collector Voltage
